Crafting Your Board Development Roadmap

Board Recruitment

Build the right board—intentionally.

- Use a [board matrix](#) to identify your strategic needs
- Define clear [role descriptions](#) & expectations ([checklist version](#))
- Formalize an interview process (activate a Nominating Committee)

Outcome: a skills-aligned, diverse, mission-ready board.

Board Development & Education

Empower board members to lead effectively.

- Conduct regular [self-assessments](#)
- Assess & clarify committee structure and purpose
- Offer ongoing governance education (e.g. [BoardStrong](#))

Outcome: confident board members who understand their role and impact.

Board Engagement

Turn attendance into accountability.

- Communicate consistently (and automate where possible)
- Add a “mission moment” agenda item to meetings
- Require committee participation & hold an annual board retreat ([template agenda here](#))

Outcome: an engaged board that shows up and follows through.

Board Involvement in Fundraising

Create shared ownership of sustainability.

- Share your high-level fundraising strategy

- Define relationship-building actions for board members
- Encourage personally significant giving
- Track progress and celebrate wins

Outcome: board members who support fundraising in strategic, authentic ways.
